





The Growing E-Cig Market in the U.S.

- The last 5 years and future predictions
- Impacted of Federal and State regulations
- Without FDA guidance, states and local governments are imposing restricting.





U.S. Food and Drug Administration Overview

- Within U.S. Department of Health and Human Services
- FDA is responsible for the safety :
 - Human and animal drugs, Biological products, Medical devices
 - Food (including dietary supplements)
 - Cosmetics
 - Tobacco



Electronic Cigarettes: Are they subject to FDA Regulation?

- The Tobacco Control Act (2009) regulates tobacco products for public health.
- What is a "tobacco product"? Defined as "anything made or derived from tobacco intended for human consumption, including any component, part or accessory of a tobacco product." But...





What Is "Tobacco?

- The TCA gives FDA authority over:
 - Cigarettes
 - -Cigarette tobacco
 - -Smokeless tobacco
 - Roll-your-own tobacco
- Not included: other tobacco products, i.e., e-cigarettes, cigars, pipe tobacco, hookah, etc.



Deeming??



- FDA may "deem" other tobacco products to be regulated products subject to FDA's authority under the Tobacco Control Act.
- Are they drug delivery devices?

A Quick History

- The 2008 Chinese imports
- Drugs and medical devices need FDA <u>premarket</u> approval, and products were seized
- E-cig companies sue and claimed that they were <u>not</u> drug delivery devices, but tobacco products



The Nicotine" Question Remember the tobacco product definition



The Aftermath

- 2011
- 2014
- Public comments (135,000)
- Office of Management and Budget approval
- Federal Register
- Process may take 1-2 years; FDA may take "final action" shortly.



Possible Outcomes

- Subject to the same requirements that currently apply to tobacco products
- Unregulated tobacco products, (but <u>not</u> accessories) subject to FDA regulation
- "Components and parts" subject to regulation, but not accessories



What is Affected and What is Not?

- Nicotine-containing e-liquid?
- Hardware parts?
- Atomizer/cartomizers, tanks, cartridges, etc.







Likely "For Sure" Outcomes

- WARNING!
- Youth Sales
- Vending Machine Sales
- Free Samples
- Unauthorized Modified Risk Claims



The Feb 15, 2007 Question

- A "new" tobacco product is any product that was not marketed as of the "Grandfather Date."
- What are the premarket pathways?
- FDA said it does not believe it has the legal authority to change that date
